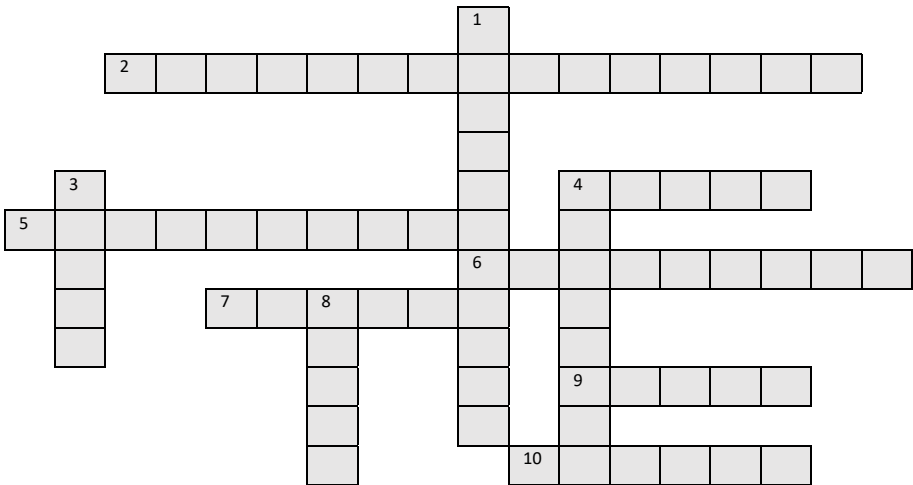


REFORMATION PUZZLE

2. ACXINIOOUMNTMCE – the practice of kicking a person out of the church.
4. MORWS – city in Germany where Luther declared, “*Here I stand, I can do no other.*”
5. TBNREEGWTI – place where Martin Luther posted his 95 theses on the door of a church
6. IRSUTHCAE – one of the two true sacraments that Luther believed as biblical.
7. ILCANV – a French reformer in Geneva in 1538.
9. HFTIA – a gift from God that is freely given and not earned.
10. EHEYRS – Luther was charged with this offence.
